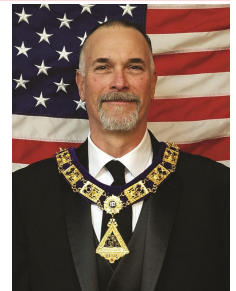

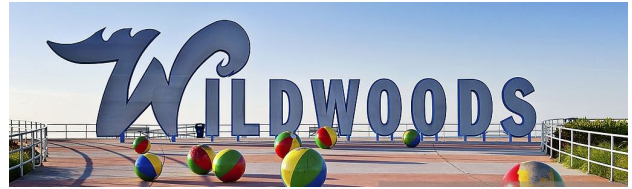
All members who are attending the convention are expected to either march or ride in the cars, if you are physically unable to march.
